

Job Title: Master Electrician

Summary: The Master Electrician position is responsible to work collaboratively with internal administration, support and technical personnel, as well as, external customers to assist in managing and coordinating electrical construction activities to meet both project and company objectives. This position will support our field crews during the installation, maintenance, and removal of electrical systems as related to a variety of industries including but not limited to utilities, industrial/commercial construction, and telecommunications.

Primary Job Responsibilities:

- Understanding and ability to perform maintenance/installation of electrical components within wireless cell sites which involves cabinet sets, DC power plants, disconnects, meter pedestals/cans, transformers, emergency generator, etc
- Read and accurately interpret construction electrical drawings
- Assist/perform civil work including grounding, trenching, and conduit installation
- Operate test equipment such as voltmeters, meg tester, amp meters, and high potential test equipment
- Understanding and compliance with company and government operating plans and procedures
- National Electric Code (NEC), OSHA, FAA, DOT, HAZMAT, etc.
- Organize materials and tools to maintain clean and neat work areas
- Adhere to and promote the environmental, health & safety policies of NCI

Minimum Qualifications:

- State of Kentucky Licensed Master Electrician for a minimum of 5 years and 1+ years electrical project management experience
- 2+ years Tower and Telecommunications Experience is preferred
- Knowledge of electricity, voltage and current relationships for both AC and DC circuits
- Ability to follow, interpret and act on written and verbal job instructions, reports, technical manuals, and data
- Ability to follow all state and federal safety regulations (OSHA) while working in an efficient and productive manner
- Valid Driver's license & Clean driving record, background check, and drug screen
- Strong written and oral communication is required
- Must have Microsoft Office skills (Excel, Word and Outlook) and organizational skills (upload photos, email updates and keep vehicle clean and maintained)
